Our veins – and what they achieve each day

Our veins transport 7,000 litres of blood to the heart each day. As a comparison: this is about the same amount of milk that each of us drinks on average during our whole lifetime. The blood is pumped up from the legs for a whole metre against the force of gravity – and that's something that only healthy veins can do.

Pregnancy changes the body

- Body weight increases by around 10 to 12 kg.
- The vascular system transports around a litre more blood.
- Hormones: progesterone expands the blood vessels, gestagen loosens the connective tissue
- The growing uterus and the weight of the baby press on the abdominal and pelvic veins.

If the blood stagnates in the expanded veins, spider veins or varicose veins can occur and the risk of thrombosis increases. It is not uncommon for the feet and lower legs to swell. 'Oedema' is the technical term – commonly known as water retention, or 'water in the legs'.

If the veins have to work harder during pregnancy, it is possible to provide them with active support. The solution: mediven compression stockings.

Swollen legs during pregnancy may indicate a number of different disorders (e.g. pre-eclampsia with high blood pressure). Please always consult your doctor if you are in any doubt.

Stockings that compress – good for veins

Medical compression stockings are the basic treatment for vein disorders. If necessary, they can be prescribed by your doctor.

If vein problems appear for the first time during pregnancy, expectant mothers are actually exempt from the statutory supplementary payment. Precise measurements are taken for the stockings in your specialist medical retailer, and trained staff will provide advice on the right option for you.

The way medical compression stockings work: simple, brilliant and without side-effects

Compression stockings help to prevent varicose veins, spider veins and water retention during and after pregnancy. Existing vein problems do not deteriorate. Because of the defined progress of the pressure they apply, medical compression stockings keep veins in shape. The pressure is strongest at the ankle and decreases towards the thigh. The venous valves close again and can pump the blood up to the heart more quickly. Swellings go down, your legs relax, and you feel fine again.

How does medi compression technology work in compression stockings?

The medi compression manufacturing process guarantees that precisely measured amounts of compression are applied to the body – for a proven positive effect on health, performance and well-being. Because of the highly elastic thread used, the compression stockings adapt perfectly to the individual shape of the leg.

Benefits for the user

medi compression provides optimum support for vein activity. The diameter of the veins in the legs is reduced, and the venous valves close again. The blood no longer moves sluggishly in the veins – it starts flowing smoothly back to the heart again. A high level of comfort is guaranteed and beautiful legs stay in shape for longer. Feelings of tired, swollen or even painful legs are alleviated, and any tendency to form varicose veins is countered. medi compression also has the effect of preventing varicose veins from occurring, for example, in people with a tendency to develop them or in pregnant women.

Healthy veins without side-effects for mother and child

mediven elegance is Germany's most popular, top-selling medical compression stocking (survey by the consumer research company GfK in 2006) and is available in a special design for expectant mothers. The pregnancy panty top has no compression, is very soft and will fit over any baby bump. If the abdomen is particularly sensitive to pressure, the version with the open panty top is recommended.

In addition to providing highly effective compression, mediven elegance is fine and transparent in appearance and comes in eleven standard colours and new trend colours every six months as well as a wide range of great product details (e.g. dermatologically tested material, Soft Elastic in the forefoot area). The fabric is permeable to air and breathable. The fibres take moisture to the outside, so that skin always feels comfortable. The stretch fabric eases the application and removal process.

mediven elegance compression stockings are available as a knee sock, thigh-length stocking and pantyhose (pregnancy pantyhose). Your doctor will decide which is best for you.

Brief Glossary of Vein Health Terms

Venous system: Every day, our veins transport around 7,000 litres of blood low in oxygen back to the heart. The superficial venous system collects the blood from the various layers of skin, and the deep venous system transports it to the heart – with the help of the muscle pumps.

Venous valves stop the blood flowing backwards. They operate as non-return valves. If the blood is being pushed upwards by the pressure of the muscle pumps, the valves open. If the blood tries to sink back, they close.

Varicose veins are a vein disease. Expanded veins in the leg can no longer fulfil their function of transporting blood. The blood congests in the veins and stretches them. The veins become visible on the surface of the skin of the legs as bulging strands.

Thrombosis: If the return flow of blood through the veins is disturbed, there is a greater risk of a blood clot (thrombus) forming. This clot blocks the vein and stops the blood from circulating.

Oedema is an accumulation of tissue fluid, causing a swelling of the tissue.

Vena-cava syndrome: When lying on the back, the uterus and child press on the large vein known as the 'vena cava', reducing the supply of blood for the mother and the unborn child.

Compression (Latin: comprimere = to press together: Medical compression hose press the veins together mechanically from outside. They are the basic treatment for vein problems. The venous valves close again and the flow of blood back to the heart is improved.

medi tips for pregnancy

- Treat yourself and your baby to a rest now and again try to avoid standing or sitting for long periods of time.
- Naturally, crossing your legs looks elegant, but the blood circulates better if you put your feet up as often as possible.
- Your mediven elegance stockings will help keep your veins healthy. After all, you do know that your stockings only work on your legs, not in the wardrobe.
- Comfortable shoes and light clothes will make you feel better.
- · In hot weather, cooling your legs down regularly is helpful.
- Your life should still include sports and exercise swimming, walking, strolling and yoga are ideal.
- Two litres of fluid a day (water, diluted fruit juices, tea) and a balanced, healthy diet will keep you healthy: fruit, vegetables, roughage, vitamins and minerals are particularly important.
